Alterations for The Standard Bank of South Africa by Cowin & Ellis: date on plan 26 November 1936. The interior of the building was subdivided to contain to following spaces: public space, banking hall accountant's office, a teller and bill counter, as well as a women's cloakroom. An existing shed was removed and a new building with Strong Room, Lunch Room, Stationery Store Room and men's toilets was erected. Estimated cost – building £5000; drainage £30; value added £1200; completion date 19 June 1937.

Internal Alterations for Stand One One Two Three (Pty) Ltd.: approved 28 November 1972; estimated cost – building R14 000; drainage R750; Architects – Morgenstern & Morgenstern (address 11th Floor, S.A. Centre, Bree Street, Johannesburg).

Internal Alterations for Stand One One Two Three (Pty) Ltd.: approved 1 March 1974; estimated cost – building R11 000; Architects – Morgenstern & Morgenstern (address 11th Floor, S.A. Centre, Bree Street, Johannesburg).
